Questions and Answers**

1. What is the hydraulic model that ACFCWCD will be providing to assess flood levels?
ACFCWCD's model was developed by Deltares and is available in the public domain.
2. Is the intent of the horizontal levee to be FEMA-certified?
Yes, it is expected that the First Mile Horizontal Levee will provide FEMA-certified flood protection.
3. Clarify the requirements of Proposed Compensation. Are estimated fees (and/or estimated hours) required, in addition to hourly rates? If so, is this detail required for Phase I or all three phases?
Please provide estimated labor hours and expenses by task for Phases 1 and 2 of each project. As noted in Addendum 1, all compensation information shall be provided in a separate marked file.
4. Is there topographic survey data available for the two project sites?
Yes, 1-meter elevation contours are available for the project areas, derived from recent LIDAR data. Data will be transferred by FTP or similar to the successful consultant.

A 1-meter resolution topographic digital elevation model (DEM) for the nine county Bay Area was also developed as part of the Adapting to Rising Tides: [Bay Area Sea Level Rise Analysis and Mapping Project](#).
